
## Monster Employment Index India Rises Seven Percent Year-over-Year

#### March 2013 Index Highlights:

- Index level rises seven percent from a year ago in March
- Shipping Marine followed by Agro Based industries sector pace all industries on the year.
   Import & Export, Oil/ Gas/ Petroleum, Power record double digit decline
- Demand among occupations up most for Customer Service followed by Arts/ Creative professionals
- Jaipur registers the strongest annual growth, Bangalore is the strongest annual gainer among major metro-markets

The Monster Employment Index India is a monthly gauge of online job posting activity based on a real-time review of millions of employer job opportunities culled from a large representative selection of career Web sites and online job listings across India. The Index does not reflect the trend of any one advertiser or source, but is an aggregate measure of the change in job listings across the industry.

"The Monster Employment Index India exhibits positive annual growth. The job opportunities have grown across all locations and most industry sectors covered by the Index. This growth is reflective of the confidence that Indian businesses have in the resiliency of Indian economy," said Sanjay Modi, Managing Director, Monster.com (India/ Middle- East/ South East Asia).

<u>Industry Year-over-year Trends:</u> 22 of the 27 industry sectors monitored by the Monster Employment Index registered expansion in online recruitment activity between March'12 and March'13.

- Shipping Marine sector (up 58 percent) followed by Agro based industries sector (up 33 percent) exhibited the highest annual growth among sectors
- Printing/Packaging sector (up 31 percent), showed positive growth in online recruitment activity between March '12 and March'13
- Import/ Export and Oil/Gas/Petroleum, Power (down 10 percent) showed steepest annual decline

<u>Occupation Year-over-year Trends:</u> Online demand improved in eight of 13 occupational groups monitored by the Monster Employment Index between March'12 and March'13.

- Customer Service (up 31 percent) followed by Arts/Creative (up 27 percent) charted the most substantial annual gains amongst the occupational groups
- Senior Management (down 49 percent) exhibited the steepest annual decline among occupation groups
